## **Anjuman-e-Burhani (Toronto)**

At an extra-ordinary meeting of Anjuman-e-Burhani (Toronto) held on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2016, at 8929 Bayview Avenue, Richmond Hill, Ontario L4B 3M6 a resolution was passed in relation to *khafd* (also recognised as *khatna* or female circumcision). Subsequent to that resolution, you are hereby informed that:

- "Hubbul watan minal imaan" is a well-known hadith of the Prophet, Mohammed Rasulullah which means "love for the land of abode is part of faith." Duat Mutlaqeen have accordingly taught us to remain loyal to the country of abode and to be law abiding and contributory citizens.
- 2. Today, the 53<sup>rd</sup> Dai al-Mutlaq, Syedna Mufaddal Saifuddin<sup>TUS</sup> continues to exhort us to the same principles, and did so in very clear terms most recently in the *zikra majlis* in Mumbai on 19 Rajab al-Asab 1437H (25 April 2016).
- 3. *Khafd* has recently been interpreted by a court in New South Wales, Australia (NSW) to be within the meaning of Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) as defined in their Crimes Act. As a result, *khafd* is now illegal in NSW.
- 4. It is likely that a similar interpretation could be adopted in the courts in Canada in respect of Canadian Criminal Code, section 268(3). Consequently and as a matter of caution, *khafd* should be considered illegal in Canada
- 5. All parents and guardians are hereby directed in the strictest terms not to carry out *khafd* under any circumstances.
- You are further instructed not to take any person outside of Canada to carry out khafd.
- 7. Parents and guardians are hereby advised that should you engage in this practice, you will be doing so against specific warning of Anjuman-e-Burhani (Toronto) and the consequences of doing so will be solely yours.
